Information for contributors to SPQEO

Rubrics

Semiconductor Physics, Quantum Electronics and Optoelectronics (SPQEO) is an international scientific journal publishing fundamental and applied papers (up to 15 pages) and short notes (up to 3 pages) in the area of:

semiconductor physics; hetero- and low-dimensional structures; physics of microelectronic devices; linear and nonlinear solid-state optics; optical storage and holography; optoelectronics and optoelectronic devices; quantum electronics; sensors.

SPQEO is published quarterly. Manuscripts should be written in English and submitted on-line to the journal site http://journal-spqeo.org.ua or by e-mail: journal@journal.spqeo.org.ua.

Rules for submission

The rules for submission of electronic copies are as follows:

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2. Acceptable graphic formats for figures: EPS, TIFF, BMP, PCX, JPG, WMF, CDR, MS Word and MS Graf (.doc), LibreOffice Draw (.odg), MicroCalc Origin (opj), Gimp (.xcf), but extremely preferable is Origin (opj) {*Tick Labels: Type is numeric, Font is default Arial, Point is 28*}. Figures created using software for mathematical and statistical calculations should be converted to one of these formats. Figures must be sent as in color version (for online access) as in gray colors (for paper version).

3. Manuscripts should be supplemented with:

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- Highlights.

- Graphical abstract.

- Short CV with ORCID and photo of each author.

- Author contribution.

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2. Title of the paper and name(s) of the author(s).

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Abstract: up to 200 words, must be presented in English.

Keywords: their amount must not exceed eight word units. In specific cases, it is acceptible to use twoor three-word terms. These words must be placed under the abstract.

Ukrainian abstract and keywords (only for the authors from Ukraine).

Equations should be entered using MS Equation Editor or LibreOffice Math. Notations should be defined when first appearing in the text.

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List of references should consist of references numbered in order of their appearance in the text.

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The SPQEO has been selected for coverage in Clarivate Analytics products and Services. Beginning with 2018 Volume 21, No 1, this publication will be indexed and abstracted in Emerging Sources Citation Index (Web of Science) and has been accepted for coverage in selected Elsevier product(s) starting with 2019 Volume 22, No 1 (SCOPUS).

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
